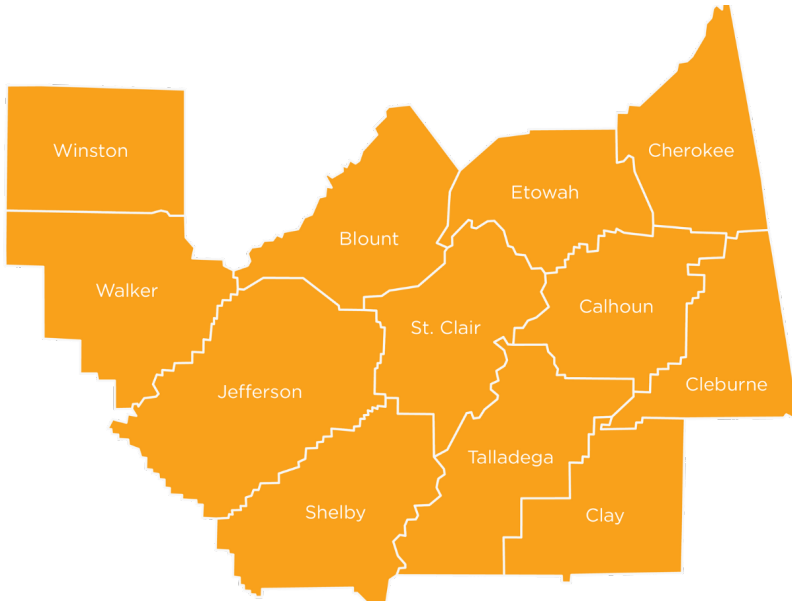
CELEBRATING 40 YEARS

Forty years ago, Joe Bruno and Dave Wood began helping those in need by delivering excess food from grocery stores using Dave's father's old pickup truck. Their efforts inspired the Community Foundation of Greater Birmingham to provide a \$100,000 grant, leading to the establishment of the Food Bank on December 1, 1982. The United Way of Central Alabama's planning department and local volunteers joined forces to begin food distribution services in Jefferson, Shelby, and Walker counties.

In 1983, we received our non-profit status, changed our name to the Community Food Bank of Central Alabama, and aimed to increase our capacity to provide for the hungry in our community. Over the years, our reach has expanded from three counties to twelve, and the number of agencies distributing food has increased from thirty to over 225. Our goal is to ensure that every family in central Alabama has access to nutritious food to live a healthy lifestyle. Although we have made progress, there is still more work to do.

In April 2021, our Board of Directors came together to develop a strategic plan to guide us as we work towards eliminating barriers to fresh and nutritious food for our neighbors. With this vision in mind, we look forward to 40 more fruitful years.

Our mission at the Community Food Bank of Central Alabama is to **FEED** our neighbors in need today and foster collaborative solutions to **END HUNGER** tomorrow.

AGENCY PARTNERS

Over our 12-county footprint, we partner with more than 225 agencies to ensure that our neighbors have access to food. Our agency partners are diverse, including church food pantries, soup kitchens, shelters, children's programs, and veterans' programs. We provide food safety training and supply the food, while our partners distribute directly into the community. Our partners are important because they know their communities best!

RETAIL RECLAMATION

Our fleet of trucks, operating five days a week, collect donations of fresh produce, meats, dairy products, and more from grocery stores across the region. Additionally, we enable our agency partners in the 12-county area to collect food from local retailers, preventing over 7.7 million pounds of wholesome food from being wasted in landfills.

VOLUNTEER & COMMUNITY SUPPORT

We strongly emphasize the community aspect of our organization, as it lies at the heart of our mission. Volunteers support us at our warehouse and by organizing food drives to collect donations. In 2022, we welcomed over 8,000 volunteers who made a critical impact on our mission. This included school-age children, college students, corporate teams, and individuals volunteering with us weekly. Additionally, we collected over 225,000 lbs. of food through food drives.

FEEDING CENTRAL ALABAMA'S CHILDREN & SENIORS

In Alabama, 9% of seniors face food insecurity. To meet this need, we collaborate with community partners and agencies to provide specially designed food boxes to ensure access to healthy and nutritious food. In 2022, we distributed over 800,000 meals to seniors. Additionally, we run initiatives to provide year-round access to healthy meals for children and families. Our programs include Family Markets and school-based food pantries designed to meet the nutritional needs of children and families in our community.

DISASTER RELIEF PROGRAM

In times of crisis, the Community Food Bank stands ready to offer emergency support wherever and whenever needed. We assist families facing difficulties in the aftermath of disaster, providing them with the help they need to get back on their feet.

A Beacon of Hope for the Community at Bethel Baptist Church's Mobile Pantry

Ms. Rosa began receiving food at Bethel Baptist Church in 2020 when the church joined the Community Food Bank's Mobile Pantry program. She drove through the line each month, as did many members of the congregation and surrounding community. But she felt a call to go further than simply receiving the food, and she started volunteering to pack the boxes and help with delivery. Despite an injured back, Ms. Rosa is a bright light—choosing to use her gifts to help her community and give back to the program that has given so much to her.

Ms. Rosa is an active member of the Bethel Baptist congregation, as are all the volunteers who come together to pack food and distribute boxes. She knows almost everyone in the long line of cars that pulls through and greets her neighbors by name. This is a special mobile pantry where the community rallies to support one another.

HOLIDAY BOXES

Our holiday food boxes offer over 24 lbs of holiday-themed, shelf-stable foods and a protein to feed a family of four for 7 to 10 days. The boxes were distributed directly through four special, large-scale distributions that served 2,400 households. The rest of the boxes were distributed across our entire 12-county service area through our agency partners.

MOBILE PANTRY

Our Mobile Pantry initiative aims to increase access to nutritious food by taking food pantries directly to communities in need. In 2022, we successfully ran 44 monthly mobile food distribution sites, providing our neighbors with convenient, safe, drive-up access to healthy food options.

BENEFITS ENROLLMENT CENTER

At our benefits enrollment center, we assist eligible low-income seniors and individuals with disabilities in finding and enrolling in beneficial programs. Our Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) outreach coordinator is dedicated to guiding individuals through the application process and helping them determine their eligibility for benefits.

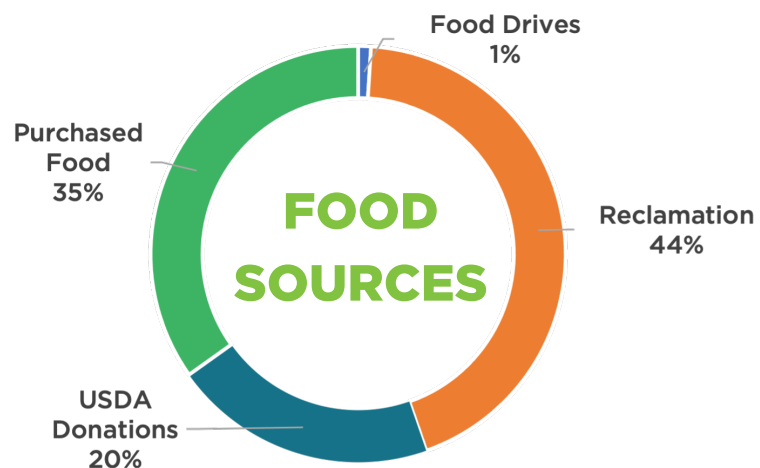
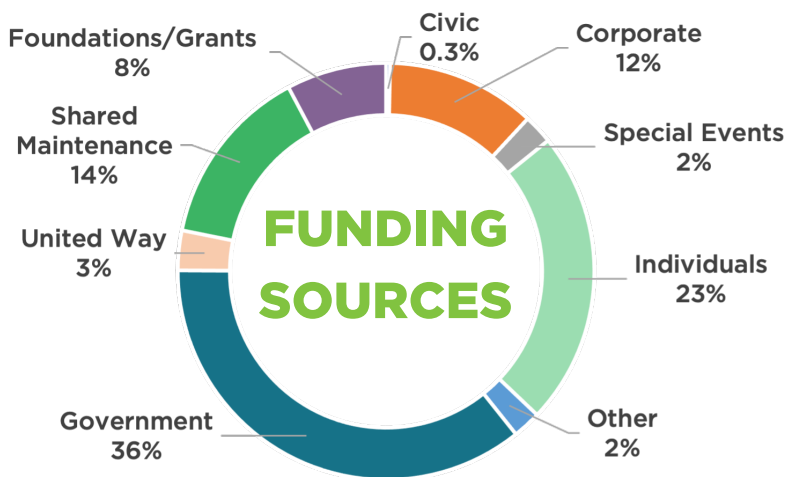
