The Community Food Bank of Central Alabama provides service for 12 counties in central Alabama: Blount, Calhoun, Cherokee, Clay, Cleburne, Etowah, Jefferson, Shelby, St. Clair, Talladega, Walker, and Winston.

We operate as a central clearinghouse for collecting food. We receive products from several sources, including the USDA, community food drives, excess food from local grocery stores, and purchasing food directly from food brokers with donated funds. In turn, we distribute that food through various direct service programs and to over 230 nonprofits in the community who are our agency partners. The agencies receive food from the Community Food Bank and distribute that food, at no cost, to our neighbors in need
