- **Legion Field Holiday Distribution in partnership with Winn-Dixie**
Date: Friday, November 22
Location: Legion Field, Birmingham, AL
Time: 9:00 a.m.
Details: Food for up to 500 households. Winn-Dixie is providing shelf-stable foods and frozen turkey.
- **Talladega Holiday Distribution**
Date: Thursday, December 5
Location: Talladega Super Speedway, Talladega, AL
Time: 9:00 a.m.
Details: Holiday boxes for 500 families
- **Fultondale Holiday Distribution in partnership with Coca-Cola Bottling Company United and Piggly Wiggly**
Date: Thursday, December 19
Location: Church of the Highlands – Fultondale Campus, Birmingham, AL
Time: 9:00 a.m.
Details: Holiday boxes for 1,000 families

Each event will begin at 9:00 a.m. The preassembled boxes will be distributed to all individuals in need of food assistance via a low-/no contact, drive through distribution. Participants are encouraged to arrive and take their spot in line early.
